Eduardo's brother Gervasio Negrete (MX) had this to say about his four most recent Ovis reports:

Kerman Sheep (February 2017): I booked my Kerman sheep hunt in Iran through Jasmin Safaris. When I arrived at the area, the local hunters had four rams located for me. We went after them but after looking them over, I decided that we could do better. We went to the tallest mountain in the area and started glassing from there. We found this ram along with another smaller ram and I made my decision. We had to go around and up another mountain in order to have a shot.

From a very difficult angle, I managed to shoot twice from over 400 yards, connecting with both shots. There was a good population of sheep in this area.

Tian Shan argali (February 2017): I booked my Tian Shan argali hunt

with Caprinae Safaris. It was a very adventurous horseback hunt. I took this argali in Kyrgyzstan along with two mid-Asian ibex.

Hume argali (February 2017): I was also successful in taking a Hume argali in Kyrgyzstan. In the picture you can see two argali on the left that my brother Eduardo Negrete got, along with mine on the far right. In the distance you can see the horses we used to get up the mountain. We booked this hunt with Caprinae Safaris and our interpreter was Mete. The snow at that time of year in Kyrgyzstan was a big problem. On our way to the hunting area we got stuck for 20 hours in our vehicle and on the way out we also got stuck in the snow. I spent 40 hours in three different vehicles on the way out. Let's just say I was not a happy camper.
